# Right now... it's all about Annie

A classic American musical comes to the CHHS Mainstage January 24-26

Based on the popular comic strip *Little Orphan Annie* by Harold Gray, the American musical *Annie* made its Broadway debut in 1977, winning the Tony Award for Best Musical. The show ran for six years in New York's Alvin Theatre, setting a record for that venue. In 1982 the movie version starring Albert Finney as Daddy Warbucks and Carol Burnett as Miss Hannigan was released. And in recognition of its 35<sup>th</sup> anniversary, a Broadway revival production opened in 2012 and ran for 487 performances before closing in 2014.

Since its Broadway release, *Annie* has become a staple of American musical theatre and has been performed by countless professional, community and school theatre groups. And now *Annie* will hit the CHHS Mainstage January 24-26!

Our directors, actors, singers, theatre techs and musicians are in the final weeks of rehearsals and preparations for the annual musical. There have been long hours of music rehearsal, dance practice, scene rehearsal and technical work that will culminate in four exciting performances. With hit songs "Tomorrow" and "It's the Hard Knock Life," audiences of all ages are sure to enjoy this uplifting, witty and heartwarming story.

Don't forget to buy your tickets in advance to ensure you have a seat for the show! And make room on your calendar to come see **Annie** a couple of times - because it's going to be that good and you are going to like it that much!
